Job Title: Maintenance Mechanic

Summary:

Responsible for ensuring employee and guest safety through the inspection and maintenance of the Wheel, Mini Golf, and all Wheel Park buildings and structures.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Comply with all OSHA and manufacturer safety regulations.
2. Conducts daily safety inspections of attractions and property.
3. Maintains required inspection and safety records.
4. Reviews work orders to determine priorities, staffing, and use of outside vendors.
5. Directs maintenance activities on utility systems to provide continuous supply of heat, electric, power, gas, or air that is required for operations.
6. Develops preventive maintenance program in conjunction with management.
7. Establish vendor contacts, solicit bids, and order all related products.
8. Ensures all working areas are safe and clean at all times.
9. Implement annual park rehab program.
10. Assists in annual park capital improvement program as required.
11. Turn on and shut off all rides daily.
12. Train and develop subordinate maintenance staff.
13. Attends required trainings.
14. Leads emergency drill trainings.
15. Ensure a clean, safe environment for employees and guests.
16. Assist with operations as required.
17. Accountable for tools and materials.
18. Complete yearly governmental certification.

Qualifications:

1. 3+ years' experience in general maintenance preferred.
2. Complete knowledge of set up and repair of equipment as it relates to: Electrical, Welding, Carpentry, Plumbing, Pumps & Motors, Fiberglass, A/C, and Refrigeration.
3. Experience in a theme park or attraction setting preferred.
4. Ability to stand for long periods of time.
5. Ability to climb up to a 90' ladder and work on delicate systems.
6. Ability to use general maintenance tools including multi-meters.
7. Extreme attention to detail, manual dexterity and an aptitude for electrical work and electronics.
8. Must be available to work an irregular schedule, including holidays, nights, and weekends.
9. Ability to work in all weather conditions.
10. Age Requirement: 18 years of age or older.

Education/Experience:

- High School Diploma required.
- Broad-technical training required (3+ years).
- English Language Proficiency.
- Theme Park or Attraction experience preferred.

Language Skills:

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to write simple correspondence. Has oral and written proficiency of the English language.

Reasoning Ability:

Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions. Ability to interpret an extensive variety of technical instructions in mathematical or diagram form and deal with several abstract and concrete variables.
